



### **Global Missions**

The Global Missions Ministry met again April 9th for their monthly meeting. We were surprised and pleased to have a firsthand report from Pastor Jeff Nellermoe, our missionary to China. He was back in town for a couple of days before he & Mim would be heading to China once again. We talked about the work being done and how they have been able to partner with others in China to expand their outreach. The question always comes up: What can we do to support your work there? Pastor Jeff said that the two big challenges are: 1) Continue to gather funds for libraries in three schools. This will provide books, tables, chairs & bookshelves. These school have nothing at this time. 2) Also needed are a couple of vans to transport both children, staff and supplies. There are two staff members in China that have driver's licenses so they are ready when that time comes to expand our reach. Donations can be made through our giving to Saint John's. Just write in the memo line of your check: CSV Library Fund, or CSV Vehicle Fund. We will make the progress known.

It's an exciting time for Global Missions. If you share this excitement, please come and join us at our next meeting scheduled for May 13 at 2 PM and meet our new Leader, Pastor Patricia Muran. Know the joy of God's hand working miles away. It's exciting!!! We certainly thank Jeff Metcalfe for leadership in carrying us to this level.
