Global Missions

The team met on May 13, 2019. Our guest speakers were Pastor Jeff and Mim Nellermoe of China Service Ventures. He recently returned from China where tensions between U.S. and China are manifest. In fact, he was detained for several hours by Chinese officials. Pastor Jeff visited with students of Shanghai University and shared the help, care and love that Christians offer to the poor and marginalized people on China. He said that each student was given a red crocheted heart as a symbol of love and the students were very receptive.

Both Jeff and Mim will return to China in July 2019 to join other believers in having 200 disabled children for summer camps. Kathy Lindstaedt of Saint John's volunteered to go once again. The Missions team would like to find funding to help her with travel expenses, so we are exploring options. Also, we're seeking ways to help raise funds for vans and library materials that China Ventures missionaries and local staff can use at schools.
