The traditional Easter greeting is an important word for us right now. Death seems to have a grip on this world, and on the hearts of so many. Fear, doubt, scarcity. These words are not resurrection words, they're tomb words. Our world seems to be waiting for renewal and hope to return, or worrying it never will. The three days in the grave conjure similar feelings in the first disciples. They too may have asked, "What will we do in the face of death and loss?"



As I write this, on Monday, March 23rd, we're still stuck on lockdown in our homes. It's only been a little over one week since we were able to gather freely in person, yet it feels like months to me. Crazy how time can stretch in such weird ways.

Giving via Online Bill Pay through your bank

If you pay your bills online through your bank's website, you can simply add Saint John's as a "payee" and we'll receive your contribution. Use the church address and phone (805) 489-1259.

Giving via Simply Giving

A very convenient way to give is through our Simply Giving program. You fill out a form and empower Simply Giving to make a weekly/monthly automatic withdrawal from your checking account. Email us in the office (office@saintjohnsag.com) and we'll send you the form.

Giving by Text

To register the first time....Enter text number, (805) 250-4073, Enter amount of donation or type "assist", SEND text. Follow prompts to register.

How do members give by text message?

After members register, they will receive instructions on how to send donations by text message. Text donations are sent to a 10-digit number where they are received and processed by Vanco. Your organization is provided with a dedicated 10-digit number.

How do members know when their donations are processed?

Members receive immediate confirmation via text that their donation was received. After a text donation has been processed, it appears on the member's credit card statement.

What payment methods are available for giving by text?

Vanco Give+ Text supports donations via credit and debit cards.

Can members set up recurring donations by text?

Yes. Donors can text "Repeat" after they've made a donation to make it recurring. They can also text "Schedule" to set up a recurring donation.
