

Make a Difference

Safe Parking at Saint John's

We are partnering with the 5 Cities Homeless Coalition and the City of Arroyo Grande to launch a pilot program to help women and children in need. Since last fall, we've been exploring a program called Safe Parking. We've been learning from churches in Santa Barbara and Washington state how to do this well.

Here's the basic idea. We will allow up to four cars to park overnight in designated spots in our parking lot to provide a safe place for homeless women (and their kids). Each applicant is screened and interviewed. We provide a parking spot and a portable bathroom. The guests stay overnight and leave each morning. Only approved cars are allowed. We monitor the situation with video cameras and volunteers staying overnight.

We're hoping this will be successful and other churches and businesses will join in. The city has been great to work with in dealing with all the permits and paperwork. They are so grateful that we're offering this option. Of course, it's just an experiment and we can stop anytime. We don't have anyone staying with us yet, and we'll let you know when the program starts.

Please be praying for these women and thinking about how we can bless them and get them back on their feet. If you'd like to get involved or have questions, please contact Pastor Greg.
