

Dress A Girl Around the World

When Greg & Cindi introduced us to the Dress a Girl Ministry, I was excited because I love to sew. But that was just the beginning! We are now celebrating our fifth year of sewing dresses and sending them off to all parts of the world. Since we started, we have sent more than 3000 dresses out - to China, Myanmar, Arua & Kampala Uganda, Mexico, and even here locally to Santa Maria for Iglesia Luterana de Santa Cruz. Last year in 2021 during COVID, we sent 1200 dress to unknown areas via Operation Christmas Child. It has been a most wonderful and meaningful experience. I encourage all of you to become involved in a ministry that grabs your heart and means something to you. Dress a Girl is a ministry that puts new clothes on little girls who might never have had a dress – ever! One of Dress a Girl's missions is to protect these girls particularly in third world countries, from human traffickers. The small 1" by 2" label sewn on to each dress, marks these girls as being a part of a protected group that human traffickers won't bother. We know that God selects a beautiful dress for each beautiful little girl, while it is still being sewn. When they get it, it is the perfect dress for them. If you would like to be a part of this ministry, we would love to have you join us. If you sew, wonderful! If you don't sew, we will be glad to teach you – we even have extra sewing machines if you don't have one. The fact is, there are many things you can do to be a part of Dress a Girl and you don't have to sew. If you know how to use scissors, combine colors, do quality control, we welcome you to the group. Of course, we can always use monetary donations, fabric donations, supplies including embellishments for the dresses, i.e., lace, rick-rack, serger thread, sewing machine needles etc. No matter how you help out, we are grateful for you.
