good. But it is good because it's not the end of the story. Easter Sunday's glory makes the horror of Friday a powerful good for us.

As we journey together through Lent, we know Sunday's coming. I hope the Rhythms of Grace that we've been learning together are filling you up with Resurrection hope. Jesus is alive and death has been defeated.

How has the resurrection of Jesus changed your life? Are you different in any way knowing that Jesus has offered you eternal life? That's your story, your testimony. If God is alive, then he must be alive and working in you.
