




Pastor's Page

Dress a Girl



How long does it take to make a Dress a Girl dress? 3 hours? 5 hours? More than that? I'm happy to say, that in the last 6 years, we have honed down the time we each spend on making a dress, fit for a child queen! On

average, making a completed dress from a kit that we prepare ahead of time will take you 1-2 hours to finish! That's amazing! Some of us spend that much time each day trying to figure out what God wants us to do on any one day. Dress a Girl needs you! Even though we make and collect more than 1200 dresses each year, "...we can do better!" Dress a Girl challenges all of you at Saint John's and beyond, to step up and be blessed by blessing the girls around the world who have never had a new dress of their own; the girls at home here in the USA and in third world countries, threatened with human trafficking. Think about this: the Dress a Girl label sewn on each dress is a signal to human traffickers that this little girl is part of a protected community. We make the dresses for the girls' confidence, to show them there is a big beautiful God loving them and protecting them, and that they can succeed in life because they are so loved. Are you up for the challenge? Think you can't sew? Think you don't have time? Is God calling you? Just say," I'm here, Lord." You will be amazed! You can learn to sew! We can teach you, just as we have many of our sewists. The blessings that we receive from this ministry are sometimes overwhelming, but always a wonderful gift from God. 
