

When they came to the place that is called The Skull, they crucified Jesus there with the criminals, one on his right and one on his left. Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing."

Luke 23:33-34



When we see things that are uncomfortable, we tend to look away. Why would we deliberately focus on something so graphic and jarring? The horror of Jesus' crucifixion is at the center of our Lenten journey. Rather than turn away, let's try and turn toward. Instead of jumping to the good news of the empty tomb, let's journey with the Lord toward his cross. His death is our death, so that his life can be our life.

We'll have many worship & fellowship opportunities this month. It starts with Shrove Tuesday/Mardi Gras on Tuesday, February 13th. Then Ash Wednesday at noon and 7pm on February 14th. We'll have our Lenten Soup Suppers on Wednesday nights starting February 21st at 6pm.



- 4. Council approved moving forward with a guest speaker; information will be provided to the congregation and community.
- 5. Council approved posting a job description/ad for the potential position of Child Center Director. Once resumes are rec'd a full report to the congregation will follow for approval.
- 6. 2 new positions were approved with the 2024 budget and will be advertised; Assistant Office Manager and Music Worship Leader.
- 7. Retreat for the new Council to be held on Feb. 3rd.
