

#### PROJECT OPPORTUNITY— WILL YOU PLEASE HELP?

We have an opportunity to partner with Bethel Lutheran Church in Santa Maria in their support of Iglesia San Juan Bautista Church that shares their church campus. This congregation is comprised mostly of immigrant agricultural workers and their families that are the working poor and need supplemental food year round. The distribution of food and material aid from the church site can be made more efficient if the storage garage and electrical supply can be up-graded. The project is to support this renovation by raising \$3300 at St. John's.The work will be done by Bethel volunteers and any of us who would like to join them. An anonymous donor from St. John's has pledged to match up to \$1650 given by others in the congregation. This can raise the \$3300 needed for materials to accomplish the renovation. ### **Council Highlights**

Highlights from the October 20, 2025 Council meeting:

- Verizon Cell Tower contract has been signed by Verizon. Verizon signed the deal on September 30th, and Greg signed on October 14th. We had a fully executed and binding copy on the 14th as was reported by Gordon to Council on the 20th. Council is waiting for the contract to be forwarded to the church. Upon a thorough review, Council anticipates signing this contract. Construction of the tower will begin sometime in 2026.
- Online Church Directory This online service allows members to access the church directory online. Only ADMINS will be able to print the full directory, which we will do periodically). Members can access the current updated directory using the email address that matches their directory listing, via a phone app, or a website. Please read the article in this month's Eagle. The current directory will be uploaded to the online version and go live in late November. To opt out, email the church office. There are security features which protect personal information of the congregation. Expect more information on this valuable service this fall.
- The Council has approved the formation of a volunteer position to help connect new members and increase participation in ministries of the church. More information will be announced in November.
- Property Day Consider coming to the church grounds for the November Property Day. Trash clean up and shrub trimming skills are always in demand. For the December Property Day, the Christmas figures are set up. Any assistance for even an hour is much appreciated.
