October Series: Pumpkin Prayers Prayer is a real treat!

This fall we're learning that prayer isn't a trick, it's a sweet way to connect with God, grow in faith, and find His guidance. Each week kids will discover how prayer can help us in everyday life, using pumpkins as a fun reminder.

Memory Verse:

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." – Philippians 4:6

Lessons:

- 1. Get Connected Just as pumpkins need to stay connected to the vine, we need daily prayer to stay nourished in faith
- 2. Lose the Gunk Pumpkins need to be cleaned out, and so do our hearts. Prayer is a time to ask for forgiveness and extend grace to others
